

SEMESTER GRADES NEW ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

Beginning January 2007 the State Eligibility Rule will go into effect along with our own guidelines for students out for an activity. Listed below are those criterias, along with dates students would be ineligible. If you have questions please contact Rocky Bennett (848-5361) or Noreen Bush (848-5431).

WINTER SPORTS/ACTIVITIES - State Rule:

Any student receiving an F will be ineligible from January 16 - February 13, 2007 (**20 calendar school days**). This rule will be enforced twice a year, the end of each semester.

Guidelines:

- Freshmen receiving an F are ineligible in that Winter Activity they are participating in until Feb 13, 2007.
- All other students receiving an F; 20 day rule will occur during the present Activity they are participating in. Students not participating in a winter activity, repercussion will occur during next season, in the sport they are a bona fide contestant in.

SPEECH & MUSIC – State Rule:

The participant is ineligible to participate in any event sanctioned by the IHSSA or IHSSA sponsored event within a period of **30 consecutive school days**.

WINTER SPORTS/ACTIVITIES/FINE ARTS - CCSD Rule:

Any student not passing 5 classes at 9 Weeks, will become ineligible until next grading period. Any student not passing 4 classes at Semester, will become ineligible until next semester grading period.

Guidelines:

- 9 Weeks - students will be ineligible from January 16 - March 23, 2007
- Semester - students will be ineligible from January 16 - June 1, 2007 (or last day of semester)

SPRING SPORTS/ACTIVITIES - State Rule:

Any student receiving an F, their ineligibility starts with the first day on which competition is allowed, not practice, for **20 calendar school days**. If they were not established in Winter Activity repercussion will occur during the Spring Season, only if they are a bona fide contestant in that sport.

- Girls Track - Ineligible dates would be Feb 12 - March 20
- Boys Track - Ineligible dates would be Feb 12 - March 21
- Boys Soccer - Ineligible dates would be March 29 - April 27
- Girls Golf - Ineligible dates would be March 21 - April 19
- Girls Tennis - Ineligible dates would be March 21 - April 19
- Girls Soccer - Ineligible dates would be April 2 – May 1
- Boys Tennis - Ineligible dates would be March 28 - April 26

SUMMER SPORTS/ACTIVITIES - State Rule:

Any student receiving an F, will have an ineligibility period of **4 consecutive weeks**. The period of 4 weeks would start after the second semester grades are issued. If they were not established in a Winter Activity or a Spring Activity repercussion will occur during the Summer Season, only if they are a bona fide contestant in that sport.
