

VISITOR TO THE SCHOOLS

It is the policy of the Board of Directors to encourage parents and other interested citizens to visit schools. To ensure that school work is not disrupted and that visitors are properly directed to the areas in which they are interested, all visitors to school district facilities will be required to report to the office of the building Principal when they enter school property.

School building regulations pertaining to visitors to the schools are to be based upon the need for preserving a proper learning environment. All visitors are expected to abide by those school regulations.

Visitors will be encouraged to visit classes in session and other activities; however, if in the judgment of the Principal a visitor's presence may have a disruptive effect the visitor will not be allowed access to a class or program in progress. Visitors who wish to speak to or interview students must respect the student's right to privacy.
