

## SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

Each kindergarten or first grade student enrolling for the first time in College Community Schools will be required to show a birth certificate or other evidence of age.

Each student enrolling for the first time in College Community Schools must have a physical examination by a licensed physician. Each student will resubmit an up-to-date certificate of health upon the request of the Superintendent of schools or his/her designee. Students shall also have such health screenings as required by law.

A certificate that a child has received the legally required immunizations against specific diseases must be provided by the child's parent or guardian when the child is enrolled in the schools for the first time, unless the student is exempted from this requirement for medical or religious reasons in accordance with law.
