

STUDENT USE OF TOBACCO

Smoking or other use of tobacco at any time by students of College Community Schools on the school campus, in the school buses, or while attending school sponsored trips is prohibited.

Disciplinary action, appropriate to the student's level of schooling and past behavior, will be taken by the school administration in the enforcement of the district's tobacco policy.

Disciplinary action may include any of the following actions:

1. Suspension from school and school bus, either in-school or out-of-school suspension, not to exceed five days.
2. Suspension from extracurricular activities.
3. Restrictions on a student's unscheduled time.
4. Combination of the aforementioned actions.

Continued violation of tobacco regulations may also include:

1. Student enrollment in a smoking cessation program.
2. Contact of law enforcement authorities.
3. Extended out-of-school suspension.
4. Expulsion from school per board policy.
