

**EMERGENCY CLOSINGS**

The Superintendent has the authority to close the schools or dismiss them early in case of severe weather or other emergency conditions, for the length of time the emergency exists.

As soon as the decision to close has been made, the Superintendent will request designated radio and television stations in the area to broadcast public announcements of the closing.

Students, parents, and staff will be informed early in each school year of the procedures that will be used to inform them of emergency closings. If school is closed for an emergency, employees are to report for work in accordance with district policy and regulations.

Scheduling of make-up days beyond those covered by the school calendar will require Board of Director's consideration.
