

ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PROGRAMS

The Board of Directors realizes that occasionally some students cannot properly function within the regular instructional program. Therefore, the Board of Directors authorizes the Superintendent to establish appropriate alternative programs for students who are not making adequate progress in the regular program or whose behavior is disruptive to the educational process of the student in question or to the school in general.

These alternative instructional programs shall be in addition to the programs available to the student through the services of the Area Educational Agency.

Such alternative educational programs may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1) alternative high school program
- 2) modification of the regular school day program;
- 3) in-school isolation room;
- 4) other special alternative classroom arrangements as may be deemed appropriate.
