IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING ASBESTOS

To: Parent/Guardian

In accordance with federal regulations regarding asbestos in schools, a certified inspection of the College Community Schools was conducted in July of 1988. All asbestos found in the district has been identified as to the type, amount and location. This information and recommended response action is contained in the District's AHERA Management Plan which is available for review in each of the buildings and the office of the Director of Buildings and Grounds.

A requirement of the federal regulations is to inform the district employees and building occupants or their legal guardians once each year as to the inspection, the response action taken, re-inspections and surveillance activities that are planned or in progress. Certified re-inspections are required every three years, and all schools were re-inspected in 2017.

The College Community Schools has an asbestos awareness person that has been trained and certified by an Environmental Protection Agency accredited program. Building custodians and maintenance staff have attended a 2-hour awareness training session outlining what action to take in the event of an asbestos accident.

Abatement work has been performed this year at the High School and Prairie View Elementary. Further abatement at both locations will be done as necessary.

All scheduled asbestos abatement activities are performed by state-certified workers. College community Schools is aware of the health hazards of asbestos and is taking all measures to conform to federal and state regulations.
