5-6 Building Named Prairie Creek Intermediate School

The College Community School Board unanimously approved the naming of Prairie Creek Intermediate School as the official name of the new 5-6 building which is scheduled to open next fall. The new name coincides with the addition of Prairie Point Middle School and 9th Grade Academy, which is also scheduled to be completed for the fall of 2009. At the completion of the construction projects, the current 6-8 middle school will become a 5-6 building and the four elementary buildings would become K-4 buildings. Prairie High School will serve grades 10-12.

In early September, a 5-6 building naming committee, which consisted of 4th and 5th graders and staff members met to propose a name for the new building. Each 4th and 5th grade classroom was invited to submit a name for consideration as they will represent the first classes that will occupy the new 5-6 building. On September 11, the committee met and reviewed all the names and narrowed it down to one recommendation to propose to the school board. At the September 15 School Board meeting, the name **Prairie Creek Intermediate School** was officially approved.

"We are very excited to be able to name the new 5-6 building," said Community Relations Director Steve Doser. "It was extremely important to create a process that involved all of our 4th and 5th graders."
