

Open Enrollment into College Community Closed

Due to continued steady growth in the College Community School District, the School Board has voted to not approve any new open enrollment requests for students wishing to attend College Community. The only exceptions are those students who already attend and their siblings.

Students who may be considering open enrolling out of the district into another Iowa public school district should be aware of the following dates:

March 1, 2017—Last day for regular open enrollment requests for the 2017-2018 school year for non-metro districts.

September 1, 2017—Last day for open enrollment requests for entering kindergarten students and those students falling under the “good cause” definition for the 2017-2018 school year.

Parents and guardians of open enrolled students whose income falls below 160 percent of the federal poverty guidelines are eligible for transportation assistance. This may be in the form of actual transportation or in the form of a cash stipend.

Parents should be aware that open enrollment might result in the loss of athletic eligibility.

Families that move from the district and desire to remain at College Community may file for open enrollment at the time of the move under the continuation provision of the rules.
